- [assign tasks](#)

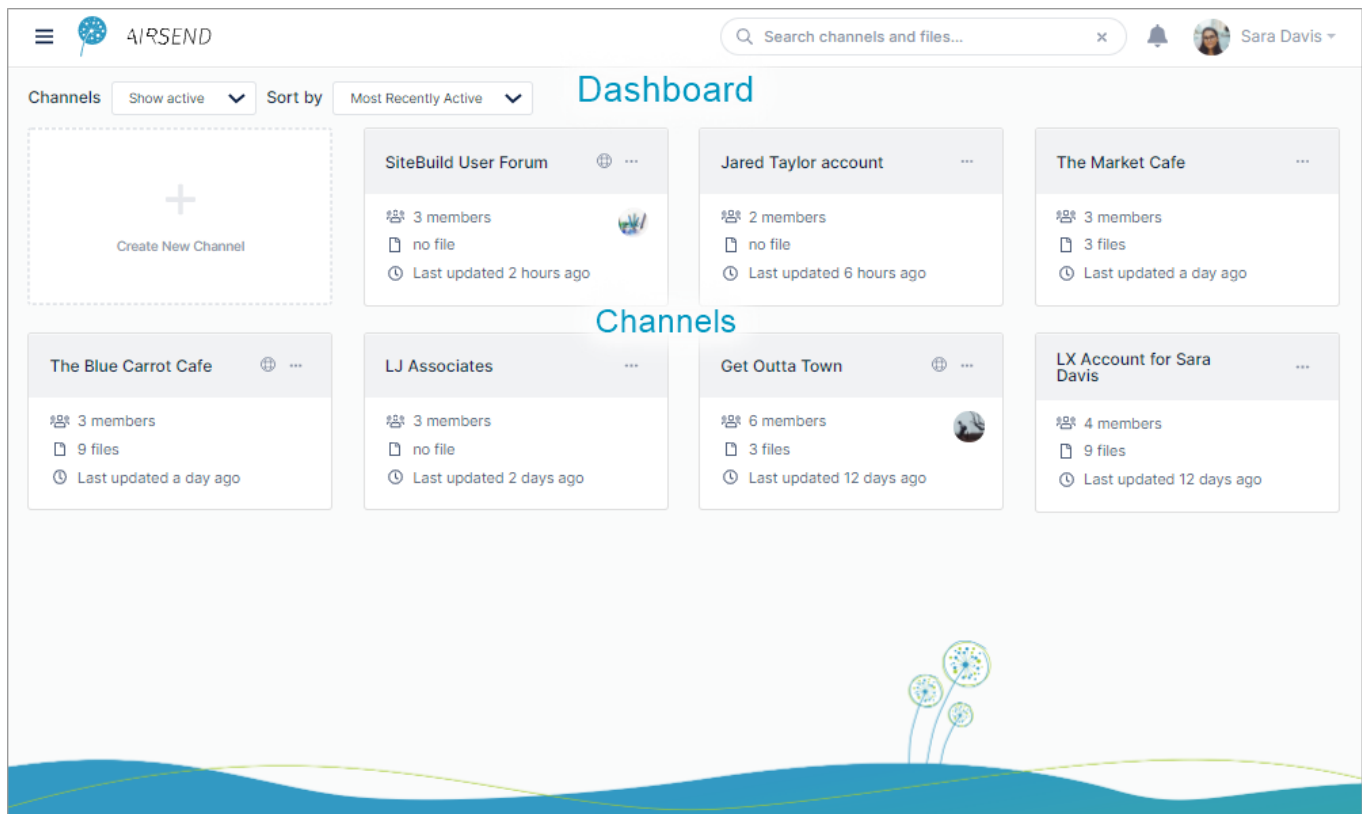
What's different is that AirSend's primary focus is quick and easy collaboration. With AirSend you can:

For best results, use the [AirSend desktop app](#) or the Chrome web browser.

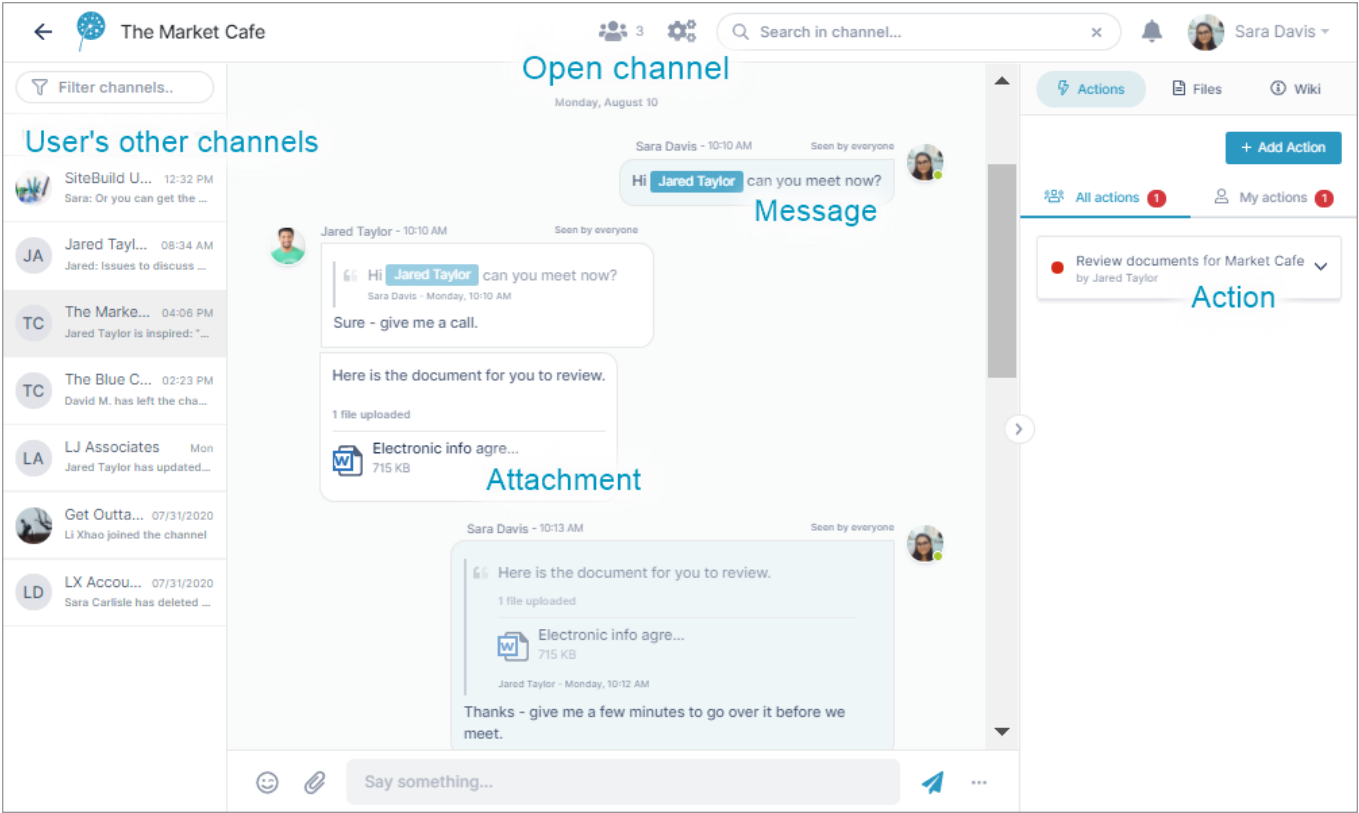
## The AirSend Dashboard

The dashboard is the workspace in AirSend where your channels for different clients, teams, and projects are located. It is the first page you see after logging in to AirSend.



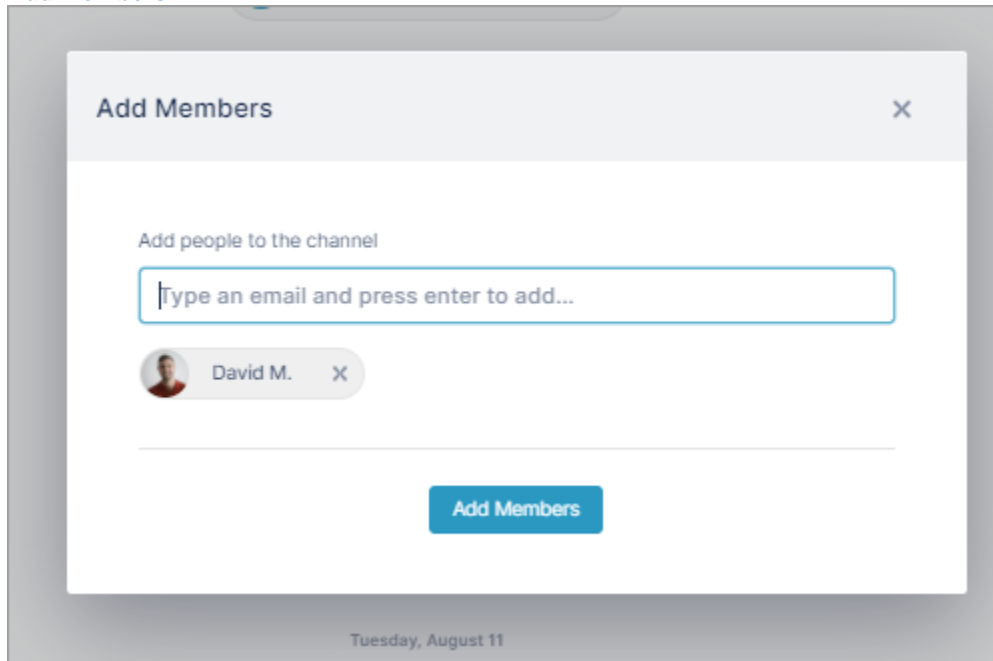
# What are channels?

Channels are the places where you collaborate with team members and clients by sharing messages, files, and actions.

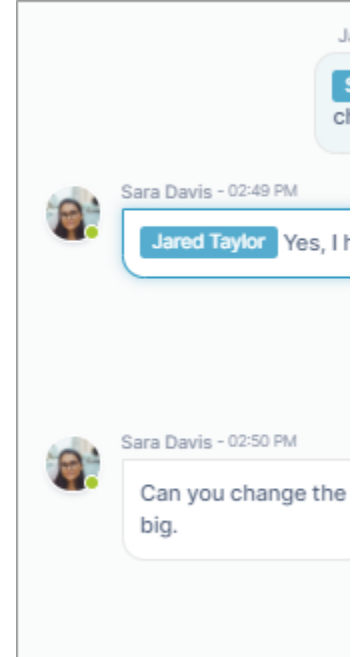

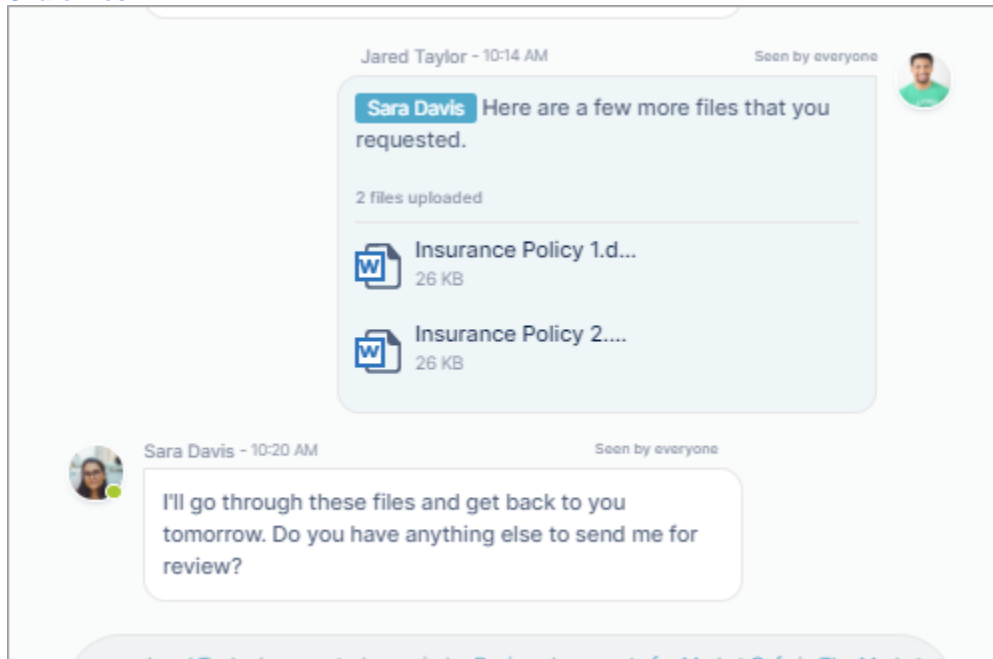

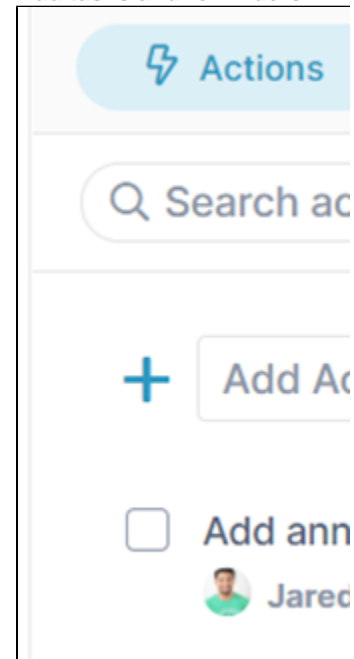
