The DLP feature is assisted by the Content Classification Engine, which streamlines data classification by automatically categorizing and organizing data based on file content.

Governance	Data Leak Prevention	Data Leak Prevention (DLP) offers greater protection against data loss when the data is at rest, in transit.  Admins can read more about Data Leak Prevention .
Governance	Content Classification Engine	The CCE is a rule-driven content classification system that enables the generic labeling of files with metadata.  Admins can read more about the Content Classification Engine .
Governance	SIEM Integration	FileCloud Server now offers integration with most major SIEM providers to provide real-time information.  Admins can read more about SIEM integration .

Drive	Data was originally only written back to the database upon exiting the Drive app	Data is now written back to the DB even if users don't perform a proper exit from the Drive app.

Disallow Commonly Used Passwords


Enabling this checkbox will prevent users from using commonly used passwords for their user accounts

Server Sync	Dialogue text would overlap in settings screen when server sync is paused
BrowserUI	The Browser UI would mark an image with Horizontal orientation if no orientation value was found.
ServerSync	ServerSync freezing or not responding if mapped folders are removed
Server	An image's Last Accessed date would not update if opened or modified
Browser UI	The UI would appear to stay logged in after changing a password, potentially causing confusion as to whether the password was su changed
Admin Dashboard	Enabling Disallow Commonly Used Passwords would in turn disallow all passwords
Mobile App	If the number of allowed versions was set to -1, iPhone and Android users were unable to upload files.
Drive	The Get Logs button on Drive2's admin UI was failing to get the requested logs.
Server	When previewing shared files that only have View permissions, Office file types would fail to show
Drive	Drive2 was deleting empty files upon creation

Sync	Server Sync now has an option to scan for file changes at a set frequency to detect file modifications when large files are being save
Sync	Sync no longer skips files or folders with '/' in them on Mac OS
Sync	Sync client no longer overwrites existing NTFS permissions
Sync	Server audit logs no longer contain too many registermc API calls
Sync	Approval dialog for numerous files changes no longer appears for a small number of files
Server	Download permission is no longer required for maximizing a video
Server	Users can specify sort selections based on the admin setting.
Server	Issue with search not working for paths containing '&' has been fixed
Server	SOLR issue for multi-tenant setup has been fixed
Server	If an upgrade is performed, the FileCloud control panel now points to the filecloud.conf file, where changes made to the apache conf stored.
Server	In multi-tenant sites, only default site will allow upgrades.
BrowserUI	The Retention – Remove metadata button is no longer active when a metadata condition should be disabled
Server	When using the filter, the input field should be automatically cleared when entering a folder.
Server	Retention expiry date doesn't affect save operation anymore when not changed.
Server	When allow delete option is enabled for a group, files can be moved to a new destination without any error
Server	A new icon, indicating whether delete operation is permitted, was added to the Details panel
Server	Pagination support was added to user locks page in the admin UI
Server	Notifications list will automatically refresh every 15s
